## Patently Enabled July 2023 - What is Enablement?

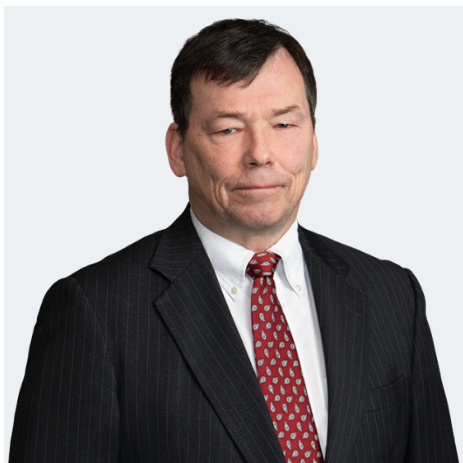
The purpose of this monthly series is to share simplified patent related information to assist non-patent practitioners in making the best decisions when considering their intellectual property rights.
